

Foreign students from EDI visit EMRI 108 facility

Ahmedabad: A group of 38 international students from 24 nations studying at Entrepreneurship Development Institute of India, Ahmedabad (EDI), visited Emergency Medical Center at Kathwada on Friday.

The GVK EMRI 108 officials showed them how one of the most efficient emergency services in the country functions. "The students included senior government officials and companies' CEOs of different nations. They are part of industrial infrastructure project prep-
